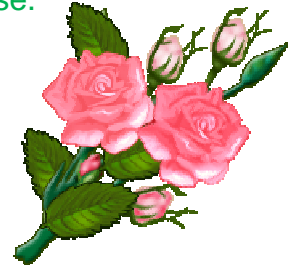

We have just received our new Care Quality Commission (the new name for the CSCI) Certificate which is now available to view online. (www.lynhales.co.uk)

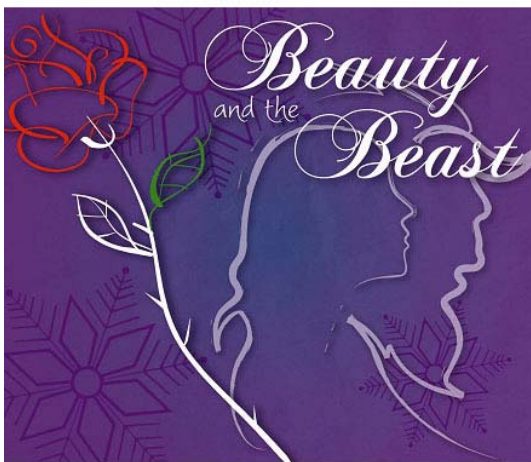
Physiotherapy
